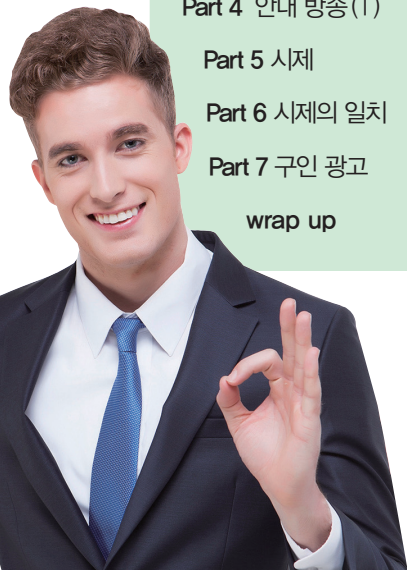

이 책의 구성과 특징



각 Chapter별로 Listening Comprehension 부분과 Reading Comprehension 부분을 통합 구성하여, 토익 시험의 실체에 가깝게 하였다.

전체적으로 학생들이 토익 시험에 관한 본격적인 실전 대비가 가능한 교과서로 구성하여 기존 교과서와 차별화를 꾀하였다.

1 Chapter의 구성

각 Part별로 토익의 실전 문제와 지시문(direction)을 두어 실전 문제 풀이에 완벽하게 대비할 수 있게 하였다. 그리고 중간에 'GIVE IT A TRY'를 두어 앞서 학습한 문제 및 유형을 다시 학습할 수 있게 하여, 반복 학습을 통해 학습 효과가 향상되도록 하였다.

또한 주요 의문사, 접속사, 전치사, 동명사, 현재분사, 시제의 쓰임, 예문 등을 핵심적인 내용만 추려 일목요연하게 문법 사항을 정리할 수 있게 하였다.
